2.21.02	January minutes to be amended in item 3 from “reduce speed” to “reduce speeding”.
2.21.03	Whiteway traffic safety initiative- Kirsty Edwards to put together a cost proposal for speed radar signs and other speed calming measures for the colony. Miserden PC now on list for borrowing Gloucestershire Highways radar guns. Lucky Severn lottery funding – Julie to investigate further.
2.21.04	Planning permission for Misarden Park alterations S21/0159/LBC approved based on provided information, 3 votes yes with no comments.
2.21.05	Defibrillator box in Camp and Miserden – electrician to fix overhead lights
2.21.06	Dog waste bins – Honeycombe Lane bin needs new lid Camp lane/ Bunnage Farm Lane needs bin on Painswick side as dog walkers are throwing dog waste bags into Greystones Farm resident’s hedge. Julie to investigate whether SCD will provide additional bin, otherwise Gwen to contact Painswick council to see if they will contribute towards cost as it is on parish border.
2.21.07	Martin to deliver council election packs mid-March.
2.21.08	Dog thefts – local dog theft awareness, spread word to parishioners to be vigilant and report suspicious people/vehicles to police immediately.
