| 5.21.5 | Parking continues to be a major issue in Miserden on weekends and evenings outside pub. MPC to meet with Miserden Estate/Nicholas Wills to address problem and find solution. |
| 5.21.6 | Newly elected County Councillor, Sue Williams attended meeting, several of our ongoing projects and issues around the parish were presented to her. Whiteway speed reduction plan presented, Sue to look into using some of her budget for road/highway improvements to help this problem. The Parish Council expressed desire to decrease speed in Whiteway and Wishanger to 20 mph. |
