11.20.02	October minutes approved.
11.20.03	Estate contacted regarding overflow visitor parking. Informed of long term plans to encourage parking near biomass boiler. Parking congestion near pub determined not to be an obstruction by police.
11.20.04	£500-600 expenditure approved by council for new Parish Council laptop. Gwen to research and purchase ASAP.
11.20.05	Council website updates and links to social media presence approved to boost community involvement and awareness. Gwen to maintain.
11.20.06	Martin attempted to reach Barclay's bank regarding Community Account, however due to pandemic and subsequent short staff, he was unable to reach anyone. Russ to ring Co-op bank to add Gwen to account and update address to Arreton Cottage.
11.20.07	Defibrillator update: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Martin to sort new supplies from Community Heartbeat Trust • Richard oiled door at The Camp defibrillator phone box and spoke with residents in adjacent cottage, they will keep bins clear of door to maintain access • Richard to obtain quote for painting/restoration, particularly the Camp box
11.20.08	Parish Post delivery query from community regarding cleanliness due to current COVID-19 crisis, it was determined sufficient time from printer to delivery personnel fell within recommended guidelines.
11.20.09	Confirmation obtained that builders working on Lypiatt Cottage to park on grass so footpath isn't blocked.
11.20.10	Drains at The Camp – Martin to obtain contact with Highways Dept and query. Gideon to chop back elm saplings to help prevent further congestion. Miserden Parish Council cleared drains at Henley Farm corner.
11.20.11	No December meeting. Next meeting to be held via Zoom 26 th January 2021. Suggestions for 2021 precepts: Defibrillator refurbishment, community recycling/Terra cycle point in village, bus shelter in Whiteway refurbishment to include re-roofing. Budget to be discussed in January.
